- Players must only enter one category
- Parents are requested to refrain from interference in matches.
- Please report to the tournament desk 30 minutes before your match is scheduled to start.
- Knockout draws will be used where entry numbers allow.
- Current England Squash & Racketball disciplinary procedures will be enforced for this tournament. Withdrawal from the tournament must be notified to the organiser as soon as possible by telephone and with a valid reason. Your reason for withdrawal should then be confirmed in writing to England Squash and Racketball within 7 days and, in the event of illness or injury should be accompanied by a letter of explanation (from parent, coach or medical certificate)
- Players will be required to mark matches if instructed by the tournament organisers
- Results from this Sanctioned Event will be forwarded immediately to England Squash for ranking and seeding purposes.
- All players must wear clothing appropriate for squash & non marking shoes only.
- Protective goggles must be worn for all matches and must comply to BS 7930.1
- The England Squash & Racketball Code of Conduct shall apply.
- Entry numbers may be restricted for all categories if required.
- In the event of a dispute the tournament referees decision will be final.
